TRINITY SUNDAY - 27th May 2018



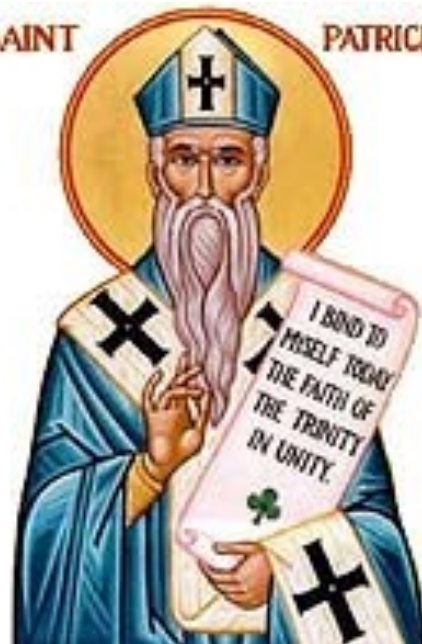
*I bind unto myself today
