THE LIGHT IS ON

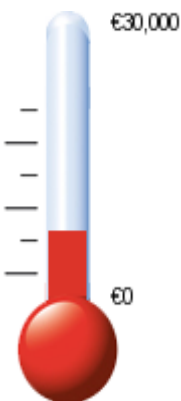
